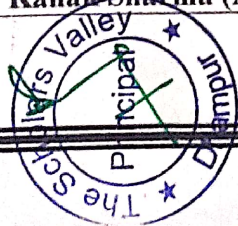

1. The session started w.e.f 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2025.

The Average Aggregate Percentage of the Students in Class X Board Exam was 64.66% and Class XII Board Exam was 70.03%.
